

What is the CPEP Program?

The Career Pathways Entry Program (CPEP) at CCV helps participants gain access to high-paying careers in manufacturing, healthcare, and human services!

Program components

Phase One- Pre-Employment

- FREE hybrid course through CCV, choosing from:
 - Introduction to Healthcare
 - Introduction to Human Services
 - Principles of Manufacturing
- A \$560 stipend based on class attendance
- Job shadow experiences with Vermont employers
- Industry recognized credentials:
 - Healthcare: Infection Control and OSHA-10
 - Human Services: Mental Health First Aid
 - Manufacturing: MSSC:Safety & MSSC:Quality Practices & Measurement

Phase Two- Application for Employment

- Professional employment coaching:
 - Resume and Cover letter
 - Job search and application support
 - Interviewing skill building
 - Goal setting

Phase Three-Post Employment Continuing Education

- Earn additional 12 college credits at CCV, paid for by CPEP
- Apprenticeships

What is the profile of a CPEP participant?

- A Vermont resident 17+ who aligns with any of the following:
 - A career seeker or changer
 - o Unsure about what career or education pathway to pursue
 - Unemployed or under employed
 - Wants to explore careers in manufacturing, healthcare, or human services
