HOW WE DO IT

We use **restorative practices** and community values to foster healing, accountability, and repair for people impacted by, and responsible for, harm, conflict and crime in our community.

These programs bring community members across Chittenden County together to support each other through conflict, harm, and healing.

Sometimes that looks like being part of a circle to explore impact and needs after harm. Sometimes it's connecting with someone after they've experienced harm to help with resource navigation and systems advocacy.

We seek volunteers who reflect the communities we serve, and we welcome people who are BIPOC, LGBTQ+, survivors of violence, people who have been criminal legal system involved, and people with lived experience related to mental health and substance use to apply.
