What is the CPEP Program?

The Career Pathways Entry Program (CPEP) at CCV helps participants gain access to high-paying careers in manufacturing, healthcare, and human services!

What do participants receive (choose one pathway)

Manufacturing pathway (May 27-August 17)

- Paid for by CPEP: Two hybrid courses = 6 credits (Principles of Manufacturing 1&2)
- Access to Certified Production Technician Certification
- \$1023 stipend
- Job shadows with local employer
- Career Launch career education (May 26-August 11th, Tuesday evenings online)

Healthcare pathway (July 7- August 17 or May 26- August 17)

- Paid for by CPEP: One hybrid courses = 3 credits (Introduction to Healthcare)
- Access to OSHA 10 and Infection Control Certifications
- \$1023 stipend
- Job shadows with local employer
- Career Launch career education (May 26-August 11th, Tuesday evenings online)

Human services pathway (May 27-August 12)

- Paid for by CPEP: One hybrid courses = 3 credits (Introduction to Human Services)
- Access to Mental Health First Aid Certification
- \$1023 stipend
- Job shadows with local employer
- Career Launch career education (May 26-August 11th, Tuesday evenings online)
